

Here is a very loose version of a plan. I wondered if I might have 15 minutes in the children's individual classes to get the first responses and then I can go off and develop the bit to get us into the parade structure. Then both classes could meet in the hall. These are only possible ideas I'm very open to fitting around what we all want to do.

The chorus could be the more taught section, Alice in Wonderland and Barnum style.  
The verses could be the more creative responses of the more real sounding world of the animal.
